

RING SIZING GUIDE

OPTION 1:- MEASURING AN EXISTING FINGER

- 1. Select an existing ring that fits the desired finger.
- 2. Measure the internal diameter of the ring (in mm)



3. Use the below chart to determine your ring size.

RING SIZE	9	10	11	12	13	14	15
INTERNAL DIAMETER (MM)	15.	15.	16.	16.	16.	17.	17.
	6	9	2	5	8	2	5

OPTION 2:- MEASURE YOUR FINGER

- 1. Wrap a strip of paper or thread around your finger where you'd like your ring to be.
- $2. \, \text{Make sure that the paper/thread is pulled snug to your finger, the tighter the better, to find your best fit.} \\$
- 3. Mark the spot where the paper/thread meets and measure the distance with a ruler (mm).
- 4. Use the below chart to determine your ring size.









RING SIZE	9	10	11	12	13	14	15
CIRCUMFERENCE (MM)	49	50.	50.	51.	52.	54.	55

Please Note: If your knuckle is visibly larger than the base of your finger

- Measure your knuckle size
- Measure your Ring Size i.e base of the finger
- Pick a size between the Two
